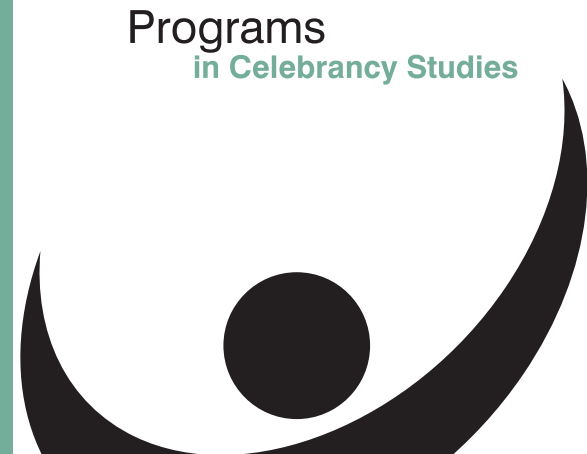


Notice Of Nondiscriminatory Policy As To Students

What is the Celebrant Foundation & Institute?

The Celebrant Foundation & Institute is a nonprofit educational organization



dedicated to training worldwide Celebrants and to promoting the use of ceremony to mark the moments and milestones in the lives of individuals, families, communities and organizations.

What is a Celebrant?

Celebrants are certified Life-Cycle® professional ceremony officiants who believe in the power and effectiveness of ceremony and ritual to serve basic needs of society and the individual. They collaborate with their clients to create and perform personalized ceremonies that reflect the client's beliefs, philosophy of life, and personality; not the Celebrant's.

Celebrants officiate at all types of ceremonies and rituals: for babies and adoptions, coming of age, marriages, commitment ceremonies, funerals and memorials. Celebrants also develop ceremonies to enrich daily life and for community, corporate and civic events. The opportunities to use ceremony to create connections among neighbors and families, and for healing and celebration, are as varied as are our Celebrants.

Who can become a Celebrant?

Celebrants come from all walks of life and a college degree is not a prerequisite. We're looking for highly motivated students who have an interest in ceremony and ritual, public speaking experience, excellent writing abilities, organizational skills and a love of the arts and working with people. Above all, the Celebrant candidate must be committed to creating personalized ceremonies for people of all beliefs and value systems.

What are the Institute's programs?

The Celebrant Foundation & Institute prepares students to become professional Celebrants by offering three certificate programs:



- Weddings and other Ceremonies for Couples
- Funerals and Ceremonies for Healing
- Ceremonies for Families & Children

The initial certificate program is seven months. Students are immersed in the theory of ceremony creation, symbolism, comparative rituals and traditions around the world, the choreography and management of ceremonies, and ceremonial public speaking. All courses are taught by experienced Celebrants who are graduates of our program.

Where do I take classes?

For New York/New Jersey area students, classes are taught at our North Jersey Institute in Montclair, New Jersey.

For distance students anywhere in the world, classes are taught in an innovative online program in small groups. Your journey to becoming a Celebrant will be enhanced by interaction with your on-line class and experienced Celebrant instructors.
